## What's Wrong with the so-called Church of Christ Plan of Salvation?

- I. History and Doctrines of the so-called Church of Christ (herein referred to as "CoC")
  - A. Originally called "The Christian Church", but they are now often referred to as "Cambellites" or "Water-dogs" or "Southern Catholics."
  - B. The name "Church of Christ" is unscriptural. Rom. 16:16 (The Body of Christ is *never* called "The Church of Christ" anywhere in either Testament.)
  - C. Began as a non-denominational church in the early 1800's in Kentucky under the defection of Barton Stone and Alexander Campbell from the Presbyterian Church.
  - D. The CoC imitate the Roman Catholic Church by promoting themselves as the *only true church* (only its members go to Heaven) to the exclusion of all others.
  - E. The CoC continue to RCC practice of taking communion every Sunday using the "proof text" of Acts 20:7. Here the "breaking of bread" is privately interpreted to mean the Lord's Supper/Communion of 1 Corinthians 10 and 11.
  - F. The CoC retain the heresies of water baptism and good works for salvation using their own private interpretation of the scriptures. 2 Peter 1:20
  - G. The CoC wrest the scriptures unto their own destruction. 2 Peter 3:16
