

Results of Tampering
with the
King James Bible

- I. Commands not to tamper with the Bible
 - A. Deut. 4:2, 12:32; Prov. 30:5-6, 13:13; Rev. 22:18-19

- II. First sin in the Bible (is **NOT** Adam and Eve eating the fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil.)
 - A. Satan casts doubt on the words of God. - Gen. 3:1 - "Yea, hath God said"

- III. First sin committed by a human being in the Bible.
 - A. **Taking away** from the words of God.
 1. Cf. Gen. 3:2 with Gen. 2:16 - Eve omits "freely"
 - B. **Adding to** the words of God.
 1. Cf. Gen 3:3 with Gen.2:17 - Eve adds "neither shall ye touch it"
 - C. **Changing** the words of God.
 1. Cf Gen. 3:3 with Gen. 2:17 - Eve changes "thou shalt surely die" to "lest ye die"

- IV. Example of Jehoiakim violating Revelation 22:18-19, esp. v. 19
 - A. Matt. 1:11 - Josias is said to have begat Jechonias.
 1. Jehoiakim's name not found in Matt. 1:11
 - B. Prov. 17:21 - Definition of "begat" or "begetteth"
 - C. 1 Chron.3:16 - Jehoiakim actually begat Jechonias.
 - D. Note: 1 Chron. 3:15 - Josias is actually Jechonias' grandfather.
 - E. Question: Why did God the Holy Spirit leave out Jehoiakim out of the lineage of Jesus Christ in Matthew 1? Possible answers:
 1. 2 Kings 23:34-37 & 2 Chron. 36:4-5 - Jehoiakim did evil in the sight of the Lord. (This could be part of the answer)
 2. Jer. 36:1 (Context is Jehoiakim, the son of Josiah) vv. 23-31
 - a. Because Jehoiakim cut and burned the roll (destroying God's words), God took Jehoiakim's name out of His Book in Matt. 1:11
